

## **The COP26 House** (information)

*"The COP26 House [was] constructed in central Glasgow for the [UN Climate Change Conference](#) held in Glasgow 1-12 November [2021]. It is located on a site owned by Scottish Enterprise, on the Broomielaw, to the East of the Kingston Bridge, a short walk from both the Scottish Event Centre (SEC) – the main COP26 conference venue – and Glasgow Central Station.*

Designed by Peter Smith, of Roderick James Architects, and developed by members of Beyond Zero Homes, the house will showcase to the world what we are able to achieve with the materials and technologies we have available today. It demonstrates a simple, affordable way to build beautiful homes which will simultaneously help us meet our climate commitments."
